#### **Total Qualification Time and Guided Learning Hours**

Total Qualification Time (TQT) is the number of notional hours it takes a typical learner to complete the course and is made up of two elements:

- the minimum number of Guided Learning Hours (GLH) the number of Tutor led contact hours
- the number of hours spent participating in a volunteering task/event that is non-guided.

For example, the number of **tutor-led contact hours (GLH) for a qualification is 9** and the number of hours spent by the **learner (non-GLH) on participating in a volunteering task or activity is 6 hours**.

Therefore, the Total Qualification Time (TQT) for the qualification is 15 hours.

#### **Progression Opportunities**

This course forms a part of the South Derbyshire Youth Volunteer Champion Award programme. Opportunities to prolong their volunteering engagement after the course will be provided.

#### **Entry Guidance**

There are no entry requirements for these qualifications.

#### **Qualification Dates**

The qualification review date is the date by which we will have carried out a review of the qualification. We work with stakeholders to make any changes necessary to meet needs and to reflect recent developments. In most cases, we'll extend the course and set a new review date. If we decide to withdraw a course, we'll set an operational end date.

# **SECTION 3 – ASSESSMENT**

#### **Staff Requirements**

SDCVS Tutors are required to have relevant teaching experience and/or a qualification, and experience and/or a qualification in the relevant subject area. Suitable teaching qualifications include:

- Level 3 or 4 Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS) or above
- Level 3 Education and Training or above
- Diploma or Certificate in Education
- Bachelors or Masters Degree in Education

These qualifications may be assessed through:

- an internally set, internally marked verified portfolio of evidence.
- observation of practical demonstration.

# **SECTION FOUR – OPERATIONAL GUIDANCE**

### Offering this Qualification

This qualification is only offered by SDCVS who is an AIM recognised centre.

#### **Registration and Certification**

SDCVS will register learners using the AIM portal. Learners must be registered onto the correct qualification via the portal.

Learners achieving a qualification will be issued with a qualification certificate detailing the achieved qualification and components. Learners who have not achieved a qualification will, on request, be issued with a component certificate detailing the components achieved.

AIM registration and certification fees will be borne by SDCVS.

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
